Thank you for your interest in selling your handcrafted work at the Pike Place Market. In order to qualify as a crafts vendor for the Market daystalls, you must make your products by hand.

Please fill out both sides of this form in order to be filed in the waitlist pool. You will be contacted via the contact information you provide if you are invited for a screening. Screenings are usually held in the fall, and selections for screening are made on the basis of:

1. The level of creative and artistic involvement by the artist.
2. Whether the product meets current product guidelines as defined by Daystall Rules & Regulations.
3. The extent to which products complement the existing Daystall Craft product mix.
4. The table availability for new artists.
5. Demonstrated qualities such as originality, skill, mastery, talent, or the potential to make exceptional work.

If your product category already has heavy representation in the daystalls at the time of screening, then you will likely not be invited at that date. At this time the following categories are heavily represented, are considered restricted and will be exceedingly limited in terms of adding new permits: screen-printed T-shirts, digital photography, flat art, scented products, and jewelry.

Food, beverages, condiments, and any product intended for ingestion will not be considered.

Please include color images of your work as hard copies, in standard letter size format (8.5 x 11 inches). We do not retain other-sized images or product samples. Applications not filled out in entirety will not be processed. Application materials are kept on file for up to 3 years and are not returned.
