About the Committees

In 2022, Friends developed two pilot Community Partnership Committees – the Pulling Together Committee (Indigenous-centered) and Community Connections Committees (Black, Indigenous, and People of Color/BIPOC-centered). In 2024, Friends of the Waterfront also launched an Accessibility Advisory Committee (experts with lived or professional experience working with disabled communities).

These are citizen advisory committees composed of leaders and community organizers who provide recommendations and feedback in support of Friends' accessibility, inclusion, and racial equity impact. Members play a critical role by informing their work along Waterfront Park and making decisions that impact their programming, community engagement, and more. All members receive stipends for their participation on these committees.
