Pike Place Market Hosts Daffodil Day Tuesday, March 19th starting at 11am – 2pm (or until supplies run out)

Next Tuesday, March 19, Pike Place Market is celebrating the first day of spring with our <u>27th Annual Daffodil Day</u>. On this day, we are inviting downtown Seattle shoppers, workers and residents to come to the Market and pick up four complimentary daffodils. We will offer daffodils from 11am – 2pm or until we run out of flowers.

Daffodils will be located under the Clock & Sign for shoppers to pick from while learning about our local flower farmers who grew them. After picking their four stems, visitors can pose for a photo in front of Market artist <u>Sally Simmons's</u> flower backdrop. We will also have a PIKE BOX tent where visitors can learn about our <u>PIKE BOX program</u> and our limited-time sign-up incentive.

This is a great opportunity for our downtown residents and workers to come down to the Market to enjoy free daffodils then grab a bite to eat or shop on their lunch break. This year, the daffodils will be provided by Market farms including:


- Blong's Garden

Please be aware of the following impacts to the Market Community:

- No parking on the south side of Pike Street from 6:00am to 4:00pm on March 19
- The busker spot under the pergola between Rachel the Piggy Bank and the ATM will have an amplified busker performing from 11am 1pm. Busker spots on Pike Street will be closed during this time.
- Temporary Delivery Load/Unload Zone, with 30 min max, on the east side of Pike Place, see map. From 6am to 3pm.
